
## Bradycardia - Arrhythmia - Summary Clinical Guideline



\* Alternatives include:

- Aminophylline /Salbutamol iv
  Dopamine
- Glucagon (if bradycardia is caused by beta-blocker or calcium channel blocker)
- Glycopyrrolate (may be used instead of atropine)

Defibrillators with external pacing facility are present throughout the Trust – your resuscitation trolley will have a sign saying where the nearest one is If a temporary pacing wire is required out of hours, contact the on-call Consultant Cardiologist via switchboard Adapted from Resuscitation Council Guideline 2015
