Children’s Emergency Department (CED)

Any emergency intubation (Cardio-respiratory arrest etc) or suspected epiglottitis, inhaled foreign body or other compromised airway

Anytime of day or night the Paediatrician attending the emergency should contact (with as much clinical information as possible)
