

## GI Bleeds - Emergency Endoscopy & Embolisation - Summary Clinical Guideline

### 1. Emergency endoscopy in theatre for pt with GI bleed:

Successful > pt managed on appropriate ward e.g. HDU/ITU

Unsuccessful > clinical decision depending on pt stability:

Open surgery

Embolisation

- Pt transferred to Hybrid theatre or Angio suite with ***appropriate medical , surgical , anaesthetic and nursing support as clinically required.***

Embolisation successful – pt returned to appropriate ward.

Embolisation unsuccessful - ? for open surgery .

### 2. Pt with recurrent GI bleed on base ward post previous successful endoscopic control of bleeding:

Decision made not to repeat endoscopy – pt for embolisation.

Pt transferred to Hybrid theatre or Angio suite with ***appropriate medical, surgical, anaesthetic and nursing support as clinically required.***

Embolisation successful – pt returned to appropriate ward.

Embolisation unsuccessful - ? for open surgery.
