Indication	Varicella zoster infection (Chickenpox)	
	Herpes infection (Shingles) or Meningitis	
Dose	Varicella 5mg/kg TDS for 5 days	
	Herpes 10mg/kg TDS for 10-14 days	
	Prophylaxis in immunosuppressed patients 400mg BD	
	All doses are based on ideal body weight Doses are reduced in renal impairment	
Preparation	Aciclovir vials contain 250mg aciclovir	
	1. Reconstitute each 250mg vial of aciclovir with 10ml sodium chloride 0.9%	
	Draw up the required amount of aciclovir into a syringe	
	3. Remove the equivalent amount from a bag of sodium chloride 0.9%	
	4. Add aciclovir to the sodium chloride 0.9% bag	
Administration	Aciclovir is infused over 1 hour using a peripheral or central line.	
	Use the aciclovir program on the VP7000 pump.
