ILOPROST 50 MICROGRAMS IN 25 ML SODIUM CHLORIDE 0.9%

Indication	For the treatment of patients with severe peripheral arterial occlusion at risk of amputation and in whom surgery or angioplasty is not possible.			
	50 micrograms in 25 mL.			
Dose	IV infusion - ONCE daily for 6 hours each day for 5 days with rate titrated as per protocol.			
Preparation	1 x 50 micrograms/0.5 mL lloprost injection			
	 Draw up 0.5 mL (50 micrograms) of the iloprost ampoule into a 50ml Luer-Lock syringe with a pink filter needle. 			
	 Using the same filter needle, make up to 25 mL with sodium chloride 0.9% and cap off. 			
	 Label syringe with contents, date of preparation and initials of staff preparing and checking infusion. 			
Administration	Can be given via a peripheral or central line.			
	Give over 6 hours (rate titrated as per protocol).			
Shelf-life	24 hours at room temperature (after dilution).			
Additional information	Contact the ward or on-call pharmacist if unsure of the calculations. Glucose 5% can also be used if necessary.			
	lloprost should only be used diluted.			
	Do not infuse iloprost with any other medicines.			
	For further information on side effects and monitoring, refer to guideline for Intravenous Iloprost Infusion.
